
Wahee Keglers Whittle QM Unit Down to Size

Seat of the German government has been moved from bomb-blasted Berlin to Breslau, a large city about 175 miles to the southeast. The new capital is situated some 680 miles from the English coast and 670 miles from the allied air base at Foggia, Italy. These figures reveal that the Nazi government machinery is still within allied bombing range. The announcement from Naples sources also stated thaat the transfer began several weeks

A recent tabulation from official allied announcements shows the score in the gigantic air war now raging over Germany is better than two-to-one. During a period of six days 440 German planes were destroyed in the air and on the ground while 195 Allied aircraft were lost.
