AGRICULTURAL.

The Effect of Eating Green Alfalfa or Clover. CAUSES BLOAT IN CATTLE. Leaves of the Plant More Heating Than the Stems - Warm Water Antidote.

I have for some time, writes W. F. Anderson in the Stockgrower, been studying the cause of bloat in cattle, the effect of eating green alfalfa or clover. I find that the alfalfa or clover when green is very heating, and when animals have eaten a quantity of it they become very thirsty, as is very often the case. The danger from the bloat is then to be feared. If warm water can be furnished, no serious results are to be apprehended; but if cold water is taken in it, when a man cuts his alfalfa four or five times during the season, the danger from the bloat is then to be feared. If they fill themselves up in the evening or fore part of the night on green clover or alfalfa, then in the morning the cool dew or frost or rain that they swallow with their feed has the same effect as drinking cold water. In close cows or sheep in a green clover or alfalfa pasture where there is no water, and become thirsty, give one lukewarm water and the other cold water, and the one that drinks the ice water will bloat up and die in fifteen minutes.

LOANABLE CAPITAL IN LARGE AMOUNTS HAS RECENTLY BEEN OFFERED IN CHICAGO AT 4 PER CENT FOR ONE YEAR, WITH THE PRIVILEGE OF PAYING BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF THAT TIME.

Loanable capital in large amounts has recently been offered in Chicago at 4 per cent for one year, with the privilege of paying before the expiration of that time.

A RECENT CENSUS BULLETIN SHOWS THAT THERE ARE IN ROUND NUMBERS 7,470,000 NEGROES IN THE UNITED STATES, OF WHOM 583,000 RESIDE NORTH OF THE OHIO AND POTOMAC RIVERS.

A recent census bulletin shows that there are in round numbers 7,470,000 negroes in the United States, of whom 583,000 reside north of the Ohio and Potomac rivers.

MARSHAL CUSHING, PRIVATE SECRETARY OF POSTMASTER GENERAL WANNAMAKER, IS MENTIONED IN WASHINGTON FOR THE PLACE OF FIRST ASSISTANT POSTMASTER-GENERAL SOON TO BE MADE VACANT.

Marshal Cushing, private secretary of Postmaster General Wannamaker, is mentioned in Washington for the place of First Assistant Postmaster-General soon to be made vacant.

THE BIDS OF TWO OF THE PRINCIPAL CONTRACTORS FOR WORK ON THE HENNEPIN CANAL HAVE BEEN REJECTED BY THE GOVERNMENT BECAUSE THE ESTIMATES WERE NOT BASED ON THE EIGHT-HOUR DAY.

The bids of two of the principal contractors for work on the Hennepin canal have been rejected by the government because the estimates were not based on the eight-hour day.

WITH NEARLY 7,000 SALOONS - 375 OF THEM ON ONE STREET - AND THIRTY THEATERS, ALL OPEN ON SUNDAY, CHICAGO DOESN'T CARE VERY MUCH WHETHER THE WORLD'S FAIR IS OPEN ON SUNDAY OR NOT.

With nearly 7,000 saloons - 375 of them on one street - and thirty theaters, all open on Sunday, Chicago doesn't care very much whether the World's Fair is open on Sunday or not.

KANSAS CITY GRAIN MEN ARE FULBRIGHT ON A DECISION OF THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL OF KANSAS, WHICH PERMITS GRAIN INSPECTORS FROM OTHER STATES TO INSPECT AND GRADE WHEAT IN THE STATE OF KANSAS.

Kansas City grain men are fulbright on a decision of the Attorney-General of Kansas, which permits grain inspectors from other states to inspect and grade wheat in the state of Kansas.

THE EARTH ON WHICH THE DEPOT OF THE NEW ORLEANS, FORT JACKSON AND GRAND ISLE RAILROAD AT NEW ORLEANS WAS CONSTRUCTED HAS CAVED IN, AND THE BUILDINGS ARE A TOTAL WRECK. THE LOSS WILL REACH \$30,000.

The earth on which the depot of the New Orleans, Fort Jackson and Grand Isle railroad at New Orleans was constructed has caved in, and the buildings are a total wreck. The loss will reach \$30,000.

A NEW SERIES OF POSTAGE STAMPS IN COMMEMORATION OF THE DISCOVERY OF AMERICA WILL SOON BE ISSUED. THEY WILL BEAR VARIOUS DESIGNS, ALL, HOWEVER, REPRESENTING A HISTORIC CHARACTER OR SOME INCIDENT IN THE LIFE OF CHRISTOPHER COLUMBUS.

A new series of postage stamps in commemoration of the discovery of America will soon be issued. They will bear various designs, all, however, representing a historic character or some incident in the life of Christopher Columbus.

THE TOTAL REALTY VALUATION IN BROOKLYN FOR 1892 IS \$497,939,395, AN INCREASE OF \$18,804,925 FROM LAST YEAR. IT WILL BE SEEN BY THIS THAT BROOKLYN IS WORTH A LITTLE MORE THAN SAN FRANCISCO, BUT ITS TAXABLE PROPERTY INCREASES ONLY ABOUT HALF AS FAST.

The total realty valuation in Brooklyn for 1892 is \$497,939,395, an increase of \$18,804,925 from last year. It will be seen by this that Brooklyn is worth a little more than San Francisco, but its taxable property increases only about half as fast.

THE STEAMSHIPS ANRANIA AND ALASKA OF THE CUNARD AND GUNION LINES STEAMED INTO PORT AT NEW YORK SATURDAY, ONE MINUTE'S TIME APART. THEY HAD A THRILLING RACE FROM EASTNET ROCK, AND WERE WITHIN HAILING DISTANCE OF EACH OTHER THE WHOLE WAY ACROSS.

The steamships Anrania and Alaska of the Cunard and Gunion lines steamed into port at New York Saturday, one minute's time apart. They had a thrilling race from Eastnet Rock, and were within hailing distance of each other the whole way across.

SENATORS ALLISON AND JONES AND CONGRESSMAN MCCREARY MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERNATIONAL MONETARY CONGRESS, THE CONSTITUTIONALITY OF THEIR APPOINTMENT BEING QUESTIONED UNDER SECTION 6, ARTICLE I OF THE CONSTITUTION, WHICH PROHIBITS THE APPOINTMENT TO AN OFFICE OF EMPLOYMENT OF A MEMBER OF EITHER HOUSE OF CONGRESS.

Senators Allison and Jones and Congressman McCreary may not participate in the International Monetary Congress, the constitutionality of their appointment being questioned under Section 6, Article I of the Constitution, which prohibits the appointment to an office of employment of a member of either House of Congress.

A SUIT HAS BEEN INSTITUTED AT BALTIMORE THAT PROMISES TO BECOME SENSATIONAL AMONG NAVY OFFICERS. THE PLAINTIFFS CHARGE THAT ENSIGN B. DASHIELL HAS MADE USE OF A PATENT OF LIEUTENANT SEABURY, AND THE CHIEF OF THE BUREAU OF ORDNANCE KNOWS THAT FACT, BUT THROUGH FAVORITISM APPROVED AND MANUFACTURED THE DESIGN OF DASHIELL.

A suit has been instituted at Baltimore that promises to become sensational among navy officers. The plaintiffs charge that Ensign B. Dashiell has made use of a patent of Lieutenant Seabury, and the chief of the bureau of ordnance knows that fact, but through favoritism approved and manufactured the design of Dashiell.

TWO EFFIGIES, CLAD IN THE UNIFORMS OF A GENERAL AND COLONEL OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MILITIA AND LABELED "GENERAL SNOWDEN" AND "COLONEL STROTHER," WERE BURNED ON THE LAKE FRONT AT CHICAGO BY 26 MEMBERS OF THE SECOND REGIMENT OF THE ILLINOIS STATE GUARD IN TOKEN OF THEIR INDIGNATION AT THE PUNISHMENT RECENTLY INFLICTED ON PRIVATE IAMS AND APPROVED BY GENERAL SNOWDEN. THE AFFAIR HAS CREATED A PROFOUND SENSATION.

Two effigies, clad in the uniforms of a General and Colonel of the Pennsylvania militia and labeled "General Snowden" and "Colonel Strother," were burned on the lake front at Chicago by 26 members of the Second Regiment of the Illinois State Guard in token of their indignation at the punishment recently inflicted on Private Iams and approved by General Snowden. The affair has created a profound sensation.
