In the name of the state of Oregon:—You are and each of you is hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled court and cause on or before six weeks from the date of the first publication of this summons, which said date of first publication is the 19th day of September 1907 and you will take notice that if you fail to appear and answer said complaint, for want of such answer, the plaintiff will apply to said court for the relief prayed for in his said complaint herein, to wit:

That the interest of said defendant Eva Frilinger in and to the premises described in complaint be decreed subsequent in time and subject to the rights, interest and lien of plaintiff; that plaintiff have judgement against said defendant, A. H.
