Cooking Tough Steak.
When steaks are so tough that they must be pounded to be edible, cook them as a fricassée. After pounding, salt and pepper the steak and dredge it heavily with flour. Place two tablespoonfuls of dripping or other frying material in a heavy iron frying pan, and when it is smoking hot lay the steak in carefully and cook well on the one side before turning—as when pan-frying fish. When quite done, remove to the back of the range, where it will keep hot; cover closely and let remain there for at least ten minutes. This method will make any steak tender, and is the best for round steaks and flanks.


