AMONG THE SCHOOLS

The Teachers' Institute at Yamhill on April 6th was well attended, and an interesting program was rendered. Pres. Pennington, of Pacific College, gave a splendid address in the evening to a crowded house.

This meeting will close the institute work for the year, as the spelling contest, field meet, examinations, etc., will demand more or less attention. These meetings have been well attended throughout the year, and the evening programs furnished by the two colleges of the county have been appreciated by all who attended.

The work of the Rallies will close with the one to be held at Rex, April 13th. The interest and attendance at these meetings have been very satisfactory, and they will be taken up again with the opening of the school year.

The College people, patrons, pupils, teachers and principals have worked together harmoniously throughout the year, all seeming to have one common thought, the best interests of the schools of all grades and classes.

A field meet will be held in Newberg, May 4th, and the spelling contest, and ciphering contest will be held in McMinnville, May 11th.

Eighth grade examinations will be held, May 9-10, and June 6-7. Requisitions for questions should be sent in now.

The following one room schools made a grade of 90 per cent or over for March: Nos. 1, 2, 5, 7, 25, 33, 42, 51, 52, 57, 61, 68, 77, 81. No. 42 has the highest grade, 99 1/2.

The larger schools that made a grade of 90 per cent and over are as follows: Nos. 11, 27, 28, 30, 48, 32, 40, 29. No. 30, Willamina has the highest, 99 7-11.
