**Mt. Angel Institution Suit Sustained by Supreme Court.**

The decision of the circuit court, in the suit for criminal libel brought by the Benedictine Sisters of Mt. Angel, Oregon, against J. E. Hosmer, editor of the Silverton Journal, was sustained Monday, by the supreme court. The opinion of the supreme court was written by Hon. Chas. L. McNary, Chief Justice McBride and his associates concurring and confirming the unanimous verdict of the jury which found J. E. Hosmer "guilty of criminal libel." The Benedictine Sisters of Mt.
