The people in this community are comin' to it. Why some of my old farmer friends out here in the country like John Crater who have lived around here all their lives used to run when you'd talk to them about milkin' cows, and now you'll see 'em makin' for the barn early in the mornin', whistlin' along, going out to pail them Jerseys and they say "It's the stuff" why? Because they know there's a nice little check comin' in every month. Every feller who has a few cows is sure of something coming in all the time. Everything that pays in dollars and cents costs a man a little disagreeable labor at times, but a lot of the drudgery is taken out of work nowadays by modern machinery and equipment of all kinds.
