



A Typical Chinese Monument

The Chinese bury their dead on the mountain side where the earth is dry and there is less danger of floods. The monuments are built along the highway to inform the public of the great men who have lived and died in the neighboring villages.

A brief history of the dead man serves as an epitaph, and a tortoise or dragon, carved into the stone, symbolizes eternal life.

Death is an expensive proposition for the Chinaman. Only the leaders of community life are honored by monuments along the highway. But by the time even the average citizen's funeral expenses are paid—with numerous pallbearers and feasts for the mourners—well, it's cheaper to live.

There is an average of one doctor to every 400,000 Chinese. So the Interchurch World Movement, in which America's evangelical bodies are cooperating, intends to cut down funeral expenses for China by opening a large number of new hospitals and by strengthening existing institutions.

Congress has set apart 1,114,000 acres of land in Idaho known as the Thunder mountain region as a national forest land. This great tract, difficult of access and having not over one per cent of its area suitable for agriculture, has for years been the scene of destructive fires and devastation due to overgrazing. It is now to be added to the Payette National forest, which adjoins it on the south, and west, and the Idaho National forest, which adjoins it on the north and west.

Institution of Phonetics Planned

The University of London is planning to build an institution of phonetics at a cost of \$600,000, where seventy assistants would be engaged in research work on the 1,000 languages of the British empire. The scheme, which originated with Daniel Jones, head of the phonetic department of the university, calls for the expenditure of \$2,500,000.
