The Cline Falls Press is no more. The bonus pap ceased and the printer dropped his "sit." The very appearance of that enterprise condemned it. A piece of commercial job work is one thing; a real newspaper is not done that way. And the public knows it.

The spirit manifested at the school bond election yesterday will cause things to be done here. It was not a blind following. The voters made careful inquiry as to the facts and the effect of their votes, their judgment was convinced and they were of one opinion and action.

Mr. Stubbs made a trip over the Columbia Southern railroad with his special train last Tuesday. That was, of course, for fun. But the fact that Central Oregon is strong enough to stand up and look the railroad hog in the eye and tell him we are growing tired of waiting is having its effect.

Judge Bean, of the Oregon supreme bench, will be Judge Bellinger's successor on the federal bench in Oregon. The choice is a good one. When Judge Bean came to the Oregon supreme court that tribunal was in a bad way. It was sunk deep in fractional politics and its decisions commanded little respect. He has rescued it from that condition, though other judges have helped him in late years, and he is fit for honest service in the federal judiciary.

Death is rarely a welcome visitor, and in such a tragedy as occurred at the Chapman homestead last Friday the grim reaper brings more than the usual pain of cutting off a promising life. All must die, however, and it does not so much matter when as how—whether in discharge of duty or in shirking. This young man, as was his wont, was doing his best—carrying his full share of the work of life—when his activities were ended in a moment. The uselessness of the sacrifice, the ease with which it might have been avoided, are elements that are present in most accidents. But accidents will continue to happen and many useful lives will go out that way. This is one of the risks of human existence, a risk that it is impossible to avoid. These bruised hearts and blasted hopes awaken the deepest sympathy in every soul and do something to strengthen the tie that binds frail humanity into some measure of fellowship.

### Death of Mrs. Morganstern.

Eleonora, wife of H. A. Morganstern, died this morning at Lytle, after a desperate illness that began on the 24th of April and involved many serious complications. Several times in this period her case seemed hopeless. For a week or more her condition was such that this termination was not unlooked for.

Mrs. Morganstern was 23 years old, her maiden name was Anderson and her former home was Chehalis, Wash. She married and went to California and the couple came from Oakland to Bend last winter.
