Great Market for Poultry Raisers.
W. B. Glafke, a member of the Board of governors of the Portland Commercial Club, has put before the club some intensely interesting figures on the poultry and egg business, for general circulation throughout the state. One hundred carloads of eggs alone were shipped into Oregon during the past 12 months. These would average the year round \$2,600 per car. Oregon growers supply the chief demand for turkeys, ducks, geese, and chickens, but four times the present production should find ready home market, while in eggs the prices would pay as well as any product grown either on the farm or in the orchard.

A Freak Rutabaga.
J. R. Brown brought to our office the fore part of the week a veritable freak in the vegetable line. It was a rutabaga that started to form all good rutabagas should, but while growing forgot its mission and tried to outdo the potatoes.
