north to south through this section. Sunday's Oregonian says that it is a move to block the Oregon Trunk by securing possession of strategic points on the Oregon Trunk Line's proposed route. The article reads in part:

Equipped with automobiles for crossing the stretch of interior Oregon from Shaniko to Klamath Falls, a party of engineers and surveyors, carrying field instruments and camping outfits, were hustled away on a special train from Portland last night over the O. R. & N. by General Manager O'Brien. Their orders are to cross the state from north to south, with the supposed purpose of spying out the strategic points and holding them against the Oregon Trunk Line, the independent railroad that announces its intention to build up the Deschutes river from its mouth to Madras and on to Lakeview.

From Deschutes the party will travel by automobile to Madras and Bend, and engineers will go over the upper Deschutes valley, seeking the most practical route for a railroad and pointing out the only feasible line for the purpose.

The danger that the Oregon Trunk may become a Hill line at any time lends impetus to the Harriman people to forestall the only live opposition project that openly plans to invade Oregon from the north, east and west.
