FORD FOR SUPERINTENDENT.

R. A. Ford, who is in the political race for the republican nomination for county superintendent of schools, was in Bend Wednesday looking after the interests of his candidacy. Mr. Ford is the man who received the endorsement of the delegates at the republican meeting held at Redmond on February 1 and at which there were present delegates from the precincts of Bend, Black Butte, Laidlaw, Montgomery, Redmond and Powell Buttes.

Prof. Ford was principal of the Prineville public school for three years and has had 20 years' experience in public school work. I experience adds anything to a man's qualifications—and of course it is admitted that it adds much—then Prof. Ford should possess in a marked degree the qualifications necessary for the office to which he aspires. At present he is living on his farm in the Cloverdale district 18 miles northwest of Bend.

W. S. U'Ren of Oregon City, the father of Statement No. 1, has challenged Judge Stephen A. Lowell of Peaslee to debate with him on the stump, the merits and demerits of Statement No. 1 to be the subject of their discussion.
