#### Numerous Showers Benefit Hay Crop.

Haying is in full progress in Crooked river valley and the Journal estimates that 10,000 tons of hay will be harvested within a radius of 10 miles of Prineville. The H. S. Cram place, four miles east of the county seat, will cut 1,100 tons.

A large amount of this hay was caught in the field by recent showers after having been cut, but the common opinion is that the rains will be of more benefit to the second crop than they have done damage to the first cutting.
