**MOVING DAY FOR ROSLAND.**

Town "Moved" for Months Now Gets Under Way.

ROSLAND, July 19.—The name "Rosland" soon will be all that remains of this town, at least at its present location, for the migration of the various buildings to La Pine, a mile south, now is well under way. The hotel practically has completed its journey to its new location, while it is stated that the remaining buildings of Rosland are to follow fast upon its heels.

Not a little amusement has been caused Rosland's residents by the elaborate "stories" that have appeared in the papers of the county, as well as those of Portland, concerning the town's demise and reincarnation as La Pine. As long ago as the first of June, before a building had been moved, "Rosland Moved a Mile," was the caption of a picturesque yarn. Since then the adaptable town has been "moved" at least half a dozen times. It is believed that some hitch in the plans for removing the Rosland postoffice and re-christening it may have caused a short delay to comply the requirements of the postal authorities. The work of moving the office, however, will be commenced next week, the name "Rosland" being retained until permission to call it "La Pine" is received from Washington.
