TOWNS IN SOUTH

THREE BELOW CRESCENT

Corral Springs, Wakefield and Crater are Platted—Railroad Crews Busy West of Crescent—New Auto Line Projected.

CRESCENT, Ore., July 25.—Now two more new townsites on the line of the Oregon Trunk in Klamath County are being platted and will be on the market about September 1.

These new towns are to be called Corral and Wakefield and are the property of the Central Oregon Improvement Company, which owns Crescent. Corral Springs is 18 miles south of Crescent and Wakefield is 25. The latter town has been named for L. F. Wakefield, general agent of the company. Wakefield will be a rival of the new townsite of Crater, recently platted by Seattle men, of whom R. A. Kittenger is the head. The Central Oregon Improvement Company, which owns about 600 acres, including the townsite of Crescent, also owns 320 at Corral Springs and 320 acres at Wakefield.

A pack train of thirty-five animals for Engineer Knowlton of the Southern Pacific, passed through here a few days ago, en route to the summit of the Cascade range. There are two engineering crews under the supervision of Knowlton, one at work twelve miles west of here near Hoey's ranch, the other working between Lakes Odell and Crescent and proceeding west toward Hazel Dell. At the ranch of assistant Chief Engineer H. P. Hoey of the road, carpenters are constructing several buildings, apparently for use of the railroad men.

BEAT IT IF YOU CAN.

Powell Buttes Rancher Has an Envi-able Agricultural Record.

As indicating what may be done by intelligent farming in Central Oregon, the achievement of a farmer in the Powell Buttes country is worthy of note. Two weeks ago he was cutting mature wheat hay, almost ripe enough to thresh, and following the hay wagons a grain drill was sowing oats of an early maturing variety. The hay has been sold to a railroad contractor and oats will be cut for hay early in November.

Last year this same farmer planted a field to oats of the same variety, and the oats were bound in the middle of December and threshed out of the shock in January. With hay selling from \$15 to \$18 a ton, and the prospect of the market keeping that price, the farmer will make a handsome thing out of his industry. One farmer of the district mentioned has contracted 150 tons to a railroad contractor at \$20 a ton delivered at Bend, and as the farmer will do his own hauling the gross income from each acre of ground will be a little over \$30 per acre.—Shaniko Star.
