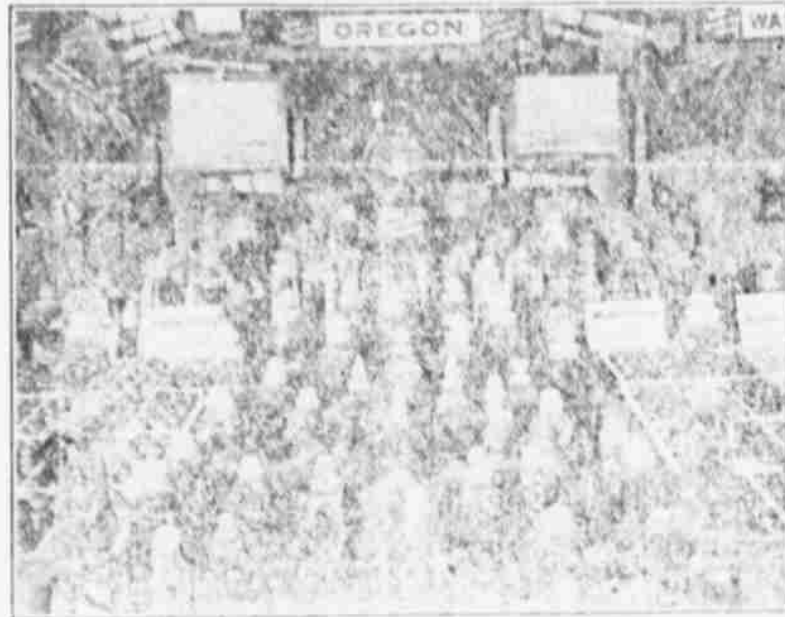

## OREGON PRODUCTS ATTRACT BIG CROWDS

Indications are for great movement of Homeseekers into Oregon's rich unsettled parts during 1911. Fruit Industry interests Central States.

"The way to get people into the Northwest is to take the Northwest to them." This is what President Hill of the Great Northern has done for Oregon by completely equipping a car with Oregon products and sending it on a 7,000 mile tour through the eastern states with traveling representatives in charge who are well versed on western conditions. The interest this car has created everywhere on its tour through Michigan, eastern Ohio and southern Indiana

has been nothing short of wonderful. Oregon is bound to gain from this practical publicity and the value of it can only be reckoned when the action for several years and some idea can be had of the number of new settlers brought into the State. The following reports of the Traveling Immigration Agents in charge of Oregon's Exhibition Car were furnished by E. C. Lundy, General Immigration Agent of the Great Northern R. Co., Greenwood, Ind.—First in homestead visitors, a great many of whom were farmers. A large number of letters were for homesteads in Oregon. The hall where the exhibition was held in the evening was crowded and some were turned away. The apple display in the car is drawing many favorable comments. Jeffersonville, Ind.—Tremendous crowd. At least 2,000 people visited the car. The crowd kept up all day long and the lecture hall was crowded in the evening. We estimated the attendance at about 1,400. The interest seems to be mostly in farm lands with a little for fruit culture. This is a

good working field and the interested class seemed to be lured among the best people. New Albany, Ind.—Nothing so far equals the attendance to the Oregon car such as we had at New Albany. Starting early in the morning we had a steady crowd of visitors for the two days. On the evening of the second day we passed through the car not less than 1,500 people between 7:00 and 9:00 p. m. ## SETTLERS MEET

MANY MEMBERS IN ORGANIZATION.

Governor West Reported Soon to Be in Bend—Inadequate Supply of Water For Lands Already Sold is Allegation.

On Friday afternoon the Central Oregon Irrigation Co.'s Water Users' Association held a meeting in the Commercial Club rooms. There were about 25 present, President P. H. Dence presiding.

The secretary reported that he had made personal canvass of the entire segregation in the interests of the organization. Up to the time of meeting 135 members had signed up, representing an acreage of 6380.

Considerable discussion of alleged lack of water upon lands already sold was indulged in; special complaint being made on the grounds that the company was selling more lands while its system was incapable of adequately supplying those already purchased and occupied by settlers. In connection with this matter Dr. Dence stated that he had received assurance from Governor West that the latter would make personal investigation of the local settlers' complaints, about the middle of April.

On motion the Board of Directors was instructed to ascertain the number of acres now occupied, the number acres sold, the water carrying capacity of the existing canals and flumes and to take steps to prevent the delivery of water to any land sold since January 1st, 1910, until land sold previously to that date had been put under water.
