

**WHEAT RAISING.**

The U. S. Government agricultural experiment stations have demonstrated beyond possibility of doubt that much of the land now devoted to wheat raising in the United States is producing little more than half as much grain per acre, if that much, as it could if proper methods of soil culture and cultivation were followed. It is claimed, on the best authority, that the proper selection of seed, and scientific cultivation, will increase the per acre yields of lands now averaging 14 to 20 bushels to 25 to 35 bushels. Such claims have been proved wherever proper trials were given the methods recommended by the experts.

We are greatly interested in the production of more wheat and better wheat in the Deschutes Valley. We need it in our business, and want to help the good work along. We will grind the screenings and give the seed back to you for the actual cost of grinding.

If you have no good wheat for seed we will undertake to get it for you. And we will sell it to you at just what it cost us. In this regard we are now corresponding with various parties in many localities endeavoring to find just the best wheat for this climate and soil. We will get wheat adapted to both dry land and irrigated land culture.

And remember that we are just as much interested in having much good wheat raised in Crook County as are you. We will do all we can to boost the wheat raising industry along. We want you to write to us. We want you to come and see us. Our interests are one.
