An ordinance to prevent the casting.

Section 1.—No person shall in person or by another, attach, place or paint any placard, poster, circular, showbill or advertisement of any nature whatsoever. except such as are or may be expressly provided by law, upon any street or sidewalk or upon any public place or object in the City of Bend or upon any fence upon any hitching post or curbstone in any public street, alley or way in the

Section 2 -- No person shall in person or by another, cast, throw, or deposit any circular-, handbills or any advertising matter whatssever in or upon any street, alley or public way in the City of

Section 3 - Any person or persons found guilty of violating any of the pro-visions of this ordinance shall be chnished by a fine not exceeding. Fifty
