**HOWARD SPINING SUC-
CEEDS NEAR BEND**

In Four Years' Time, Despite Physical
Disabilities, He Has Accomplished
Much By Hard Work—Has Great
Faith in This Country.

of Howard Spining, who came here
four years ago from Eastern Wash-
ington.

Mr. Spining had been publishing

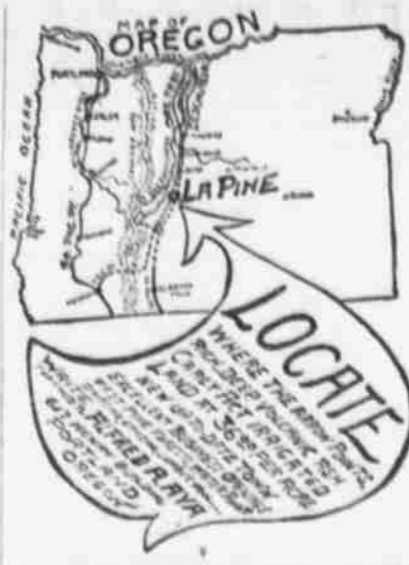

mind then the future development
of them as a treatment for a chronic
case of dyspepsia. He arrived in
Bend Oct. 15, 1907. Though handi-
capped by his 54 years, a very bad
stomach and an artificial limb, he
soon set to work on his land, and
there were but few days that he
was idle. With the assistance of a
hired man two spring seasons, he
has the tract at Powell Butte under
cultivation and irrigation and 30
acres of the Bend tract improved,
25 acres being in grass and 5 in
orchard, garden, etc. In addition,
he has erected buildings and built
fences.

During the past two years Mr.
Spining has made a living by dair-
ying on a small scale. He made his
cows each yield him \$1 a day
throughout a large part of the
season, as previously noted in The
Bulletin.

Not only has Mr. Spining suc-
ceeded at ranching, but has regained
his health. Finding that his phys-
ical disability constitutes a heavy
burden on a farmer, he is thinking
of resuming newspaper work. He
expects to sell off part of his land
and his stock in a short time, but
will retain one tract for the fancy
price which he believes is coming in
the near future.

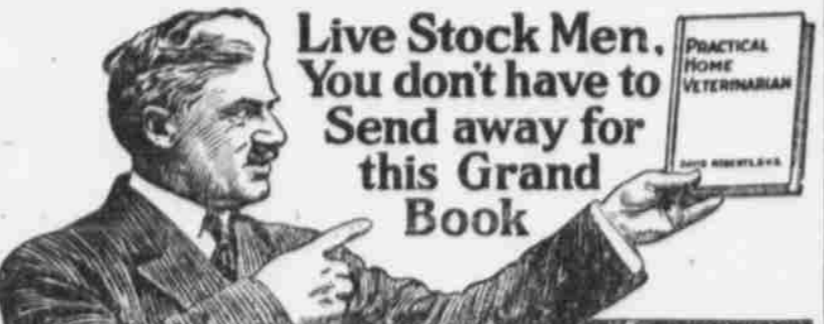
