## MORE FIRE HOSE

**COUNCIL ORDERS 500  
FEET PURCHASED**

**Cart, Appliances and Some Wrenches**  
Also Ordered Bought—Motion to  
Lower Bond Street Grade Put  
Through But Later Reconsidered

Purchase of 500 feet more of fire  
hose, with cart and appliances, was  
ordered by the City Council at its  
adjourned session last night. The  
street grade of Bond and Green-  
wood was by unanimous vote order-  
ed lowered eight inches, on motion  
of Councilman Sellers, but a little  
later the action was rescinded and  
the grade will remain as at present  
mapped. Engineer Gould was not  
present when the motion to lower  
the grade was made, and after his  
statement of what difficulties would  
be encountered in lowering the  
grade Councilman Allen moved that  
the previous action be stricken from  
the records. The vote stood: Ayes—  
Allen, Caldwell, Sellers, Noes—  
Aune, O'Neill. Absent, Kelly.

The fire protection situation was  
discussed but the only action taken  
was to buy more hose and a cart  
for it, and a few more wrenches.  
On inquiry of the mayor, Council-  
man Allen reported that The Bend  
Co. had just ordered the hydrant  
twice ordered installed at Nevada  
and Bond streets.

The resignation of C. E. Murray  
as night police officer was read and  
accepted. He has been drinking  
while on duty. C. D. Brown was  
appointed to the vacancy and went  
on duty last night.

for taking of testimony.

Not true bills were returned in  
the following cases from Bend: D.  
H. Latham, charged with negligently  
allowing a fire to escape from a  
yellow jacket's nest up river last  
summer; the hawdy house cases;  
William Linster, charged with  
wanton cruelty to animals.

The grand jury failed to find a  
true bill in the case against Deputy  
Sheriff Claude Williams, who shot  
and killed Tom Miller while taking  
him from Opal City to Prineville.

James Moore, indicted for receiv-  
ing stolen property at Opal City,  
knowing it to have been stolen, was  
given an indeterminate sentence of  
six months to five years in the  
penitentiary.
