

BUILD HOTEL AT SISTERS

DENNIS STARTS NEW STRUCTURE

Hostelry Has 19 Rooms and Modern Equipment—Other Buildings Planned for Enterprising Town, to House Butcher and Baker.

SISTERS, April 9—A modern hotel that would be a credit to a town considerably larger than Sisters is being erected here by John Dennis. It stands on a corner in the center of town, and will be two stories in height. The dimensions are 64x38 feet and it will contain 19 rooms, with two additional bath rooms. There will be a basement 33x26 feet in size.

It will be a frame structure but very substantial and well finished. Every room will be heated from a hot air furnace in the basement, and there will be hot and cold water accessible to all rooms. Work on the building is now under way, and Mr. Dennis expects to have it completed and opened in June. John Cunningham of Bend is foreman of construction.

A number of other buildings are being put up here and others are planned. Zumalt & Graham are building a meat market and butcher shop, and bids have been called for on two store buildings which will be erected by newcomers. One will probably be occupied by a bakery. Lumber has been placed on the ground for residences for William Edmiston and Robert Smith.
