

As City Treasurer Overturf did not have his regular report ready. a motion was passed instructing the recorder to ask Mr. Overturf forthwith to make such report.


The ordinance fixing street grades was read for the second time and russed. The proposition to audit the accounts of the city, made a month or so ago and laid on the table, was taken up and defeated.
