rant in favor of that fund in the sum of \$3500.

It appearing that the Coast Bridge Co. has completed the Springer canyon bridge according to its agreement. It is hereby ordered that \$2150, the price of the bridge, be paid from the road fund, and that a warrant in the sum of \$1541.70 be drawn by the county clerk on the general fund in favor of the Coast Bridge Co.

In the matter of the carload of culvert material furnished by Beal & Co. about April 5, 1912, for \$4,411.35 to be paid for one year after date; said material being satisfactory in every respect, it is ordered that a warrant be drawn on the road fund in favor of said company for \$2073, and the balance, \$2338.35, be paid from the general fund.

It is ordered that a voting precinct be formed to conform to the boundaries of the Centralia road district and a second voting precinct to conform to the boundaries of the Alfalfa road district.

A. O. Walker is hereby appointed road supervisor of Alfalfa road district No. 40.

The claim of the city of Madras for expenses in the care of the Webber children, delinquent, was continued. The claim of L. H. Irving for \$5, legal services rendered the Webber children, was allowed.

On complaint of Homer Ross et al, that there is an open ditch in front of Mrs. L. R. Lawson's residence, also an open ditch about 100 feet east of Mill creek bridge on the property of D. A. Sears; Road Supervisor Buchanan is hereby instructed to notify the owners to put in suitable culverts and prepare the crossings in first class condition; graving same properly under the direction of said road supervisor. The work to be done within 15 days after notice has been given to the owners of said ditches, and if not so done the said road supervisor is hereby ordered to place the same and charge the cost to said owners.

O. G. Collier is hereby appointed justice of the peace for Haystack precinct.
