NOTICE.

Notice is hereby given that the streets committee of the city of Bend, Oregon, has made and filed its report with the city recorder showing the property benefited by the sewer heretofore ordered laid down and constructed on the following described streets, alleys and parcels of land, to-wit:

On the alley east of Bond street from Greenwood avenue to Kentucky street; on Kentucky street from the alley east of Bond street to the alley between Wall and Bond streets; on the alley east of Wall street from Kentucky street to Nevada street; on Ohio street from the alley east of Wall street to the alley west of Wall street; on the alley west of Wall street from Kentucky street to intersection with the south and west line of block one of Bend; thence on a line 10 feet distant and parallel to the west line of block one of Bond, and block one of North Addition to Bend, and continuing on the same straight line, in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 sec. 22, T. 17 S., R. 12 E., W. M., to a point 5 feet S. of the right of way of the Oregon Trunk Ry. spur; thence easterly on a line 5 feet south of and parallel to the said Oregon Trunk Ry. spur to the center of Wall street; thence along the center of Wall street, to the intersection with the west line of tract 19, of Lytle Acres, thence northeasterly across lots 19, 18 and 17, Lytle Acres, to the street between lots 5 and 17, Lytle Acres, thence easterly along said street between tracts 5 and 17, 9 and 16, 10 and 15, 11 and 14, 12 and 13, to the Pilot Butte canal, thence in a northerly direction paralleling the Pilot Butte canal, across lots 1 and 12, Lytle Acres, to the intersection of G avenue and 7th street; thence northeasterly across block 16, Riverside, to the intersection of H avenue and the alley between 7th and 8th streets, thence northerly along the alley between 7th and 8th streets to a point opposite the line between lots 8 and 9, block 19, Riverside; thence easterly on the line between said lots 8 and 9, block 19, Riverside, to the west line of 8th street; thence northerly and diagonally across 8th street to K street where it crosses the northerly line of the city limits of Bend.
