Interprets Divorce Laws.

A divorced person cannot legally remarry in this state within six months following the date of the divorce, but he may go into another state where remarriage is permitted in less time than that and get mar-ried and then return to Oregon and the marriage will be held legal in this state, according to an opinion of the attorney general given last week. He also held that a physician cannot charge more than \$2.50 for issuing the marriage medical cer-

tificate which is required to be ob-tained by prospective bridegrooms. New Law Affects Banks. Last week the attorney general rendered an opinion that all banks having a clause in their articles of incorporation authorizing them to do a trust company business must either comply with the new trust company law or have their articles d. If a bank has the word in its name it must comply with this new law or have the word stricken out. The new statute pro-vides for a heavy deposit of securitles with the state treasurer by all trust companies for the protection 21-27 of their partrons.
