

\$500,000 ROAD BONDS CARRY

JACKSON COUNTY TAKES LEAD

By Three to One Vote People Elect To Construct 50 Miles of Permanent Highway—State Highway Commissioner in Charge.

(Portland Oregonian.)

At the request of the Jackson County Court, the State Highway Commissioner will take complete charge of the road construction work for which \$500,000 in bonds were voted in Jackson county on Tuesday. The work will be supervised in person by Major H. L. Howly, State Highway Commissioner.

Major Howly explained the purpose of the bonds and outlined his plans in the road work, which will be taken up at once.

"The \$500,000 is to be spent for a modern, first-class highway, 24 feet wide, with a hard surface 16 feet wide," said Major Howly. "The entire bond issue is for the construction of one main trunk road, from the California line to the Josephine county line. The distance is about 50 miles."

"The voting of these bonds is a big thing for Oregon. Jackson county is the first county in the state to take advantage of the county bonding act passed by the last legislature authorizing counties to issue road bonds up to 2 per cent of their assessed valuation. Jackson county's energetic action sets an example for other counties to follow."

Road Will Bring Tourists.
"Jackson county people are expecting this road to bring many 1915 tourists into the county, and it will. The county will get back more from the tourists coming through by automobiles than the entire road will cost them."

The vote on goodroads bonds in Jackson county was 3067 to 1202, or a majority of 2365. Every city and town in the county, whether on the proposed highway or not, voted for the bonds, the only opposition being in the remote districts.
