and Imperial, on an incomplete count gave a two to one margin. In the three Bend precincts about 85 per cent of the voters registered "yes" on the question. Throughout Jefferson county ran close to Deschutes, as was the case, via versa, in the north end. An unprecedentedly large vote was polled. At nearly all the precincts the vote exceeded the registration, except a few where special effort had been directed to getting the vote registered previously. Now that Jefferson county has carried, in view of possible political battles of the future, it is interesting to note that in the boundaries of the proposed Deschutes county there is a vote of 2474, as opposed to but 1166 in old Crook. In the boundaries of what will be Crook county in the future, the results of yesterday show that those who favored division totaled about 1850, while the opposition numbered 1655.
