Writes From Lakeview of Trip From-The Dalles Via Prineville and Bend -Second Gear Used Only Three Times From Here to Lakeview

"Road conditions through Central Oregon are reported the best ever known at this season of the year.' writes Harry C. Hays, traveling representative of the Howard Automolife Company, distributors of hulek cars on the Pacific Coast, seconding to the Oregonian.

In a Bulck 37 touring car, and ac-companied by Peter Lacy, driver for the Southern Oregon Auto Company, in a Bulck 1500 pound truck, Hays left The Dalles Thursday, April 1. Writing from Lakeview under the

Writing from Lakeview under the date of April 4, Hays mays: "We arrived at 10:30 last night, Taking it all in all, we had a five trip. We had splendid success with our rigs, and the roads were good, but don't forget that it is 405 long miles from The Dalles to Lakeview.

Good and Had Roads

"Last year, when we had the same trip, we protably picked the worst time to make it, and this year probably the heat.

"We left The Dalles Thursday morn in a heavy rais, and until we reached Miller's Bridge, about 14 miles out, we were in the mud all. the time.

"From Miller's Bridge to Shanike we had good roads, but from Shaniko all the way through Antelope Can-

yon the roads were really bad, "We found very slow going just outside the town of Shaniko, as here we encountered high centers and deep mud,

'After we passed through Antelope Canyon, the roads were just like paved streets clear to Princyllle.

'We stayed all night at Madras, as it was late, and we did not know the reads very well, arriving in Prineville at 9 o'clock the next moraing.

Some Mud Encountered,

Bend all night. "From Bend to La Pine we en-

countered some mud, but not enough San Francisco, to hinder us at all.

"Frem La Pine to Silver Lake I never saw better roads. The truck was abead of me and certainly did some traveling, "Just outside of Silver Lake we






