Any such k not taken within 90 days by ate capital or by a local loan orzation contemplated by the bill ild be subscribed by the Federal ernment.

Susiness would be transacted ditly between the regional banks the local bodies which farmers uld be authorized to organize in form of co-operative loan associais or joint stock banks, charters which would be passed on by the d bank board.

Interest Reduction Provided.

Applications for loans approved by local organizations would be recmended to the regional bank of district. The banks would be uthorized to loan out capital stock to sell bonds to obtain sufficient nds to make the loans, and the farers would be charged as interest he interest on the bonds plus 1 per ent. The completed bill is a compromise measure, embodying many of the features of the Hollis-Bulkeley bill of the last congress and most of the underlying principles of the Letcher-Moss fostered by the United States Commission on Rural Credits. Senstor Fletcher, president of the commission, was in consultation today with the sub-committee and will support the measure.
