

## MILL NOTES

The last shipment of lumber for the new factory of the Brooks-Scanlon Lumber Company arrived last week at the mill's plant and installation of it was early this week. As soon as this work has been completed the new factory will open at full capacity.

The Brooks-Scanlon Lumber Company reports that it is considerably improved in making its shipments to outside territory in the marketing of logs. The demand for the company's product is considerable, in view of the fact it is unique in connection with its being composed of logs.

In order to facilitate its current operations during the winter months the Brooks-Scanlon Lumber Company is planning to provide a means of moving the surplus logs of the existing pool with greater convenience.
