

# COUNTY COURT PROCEEDINGS

The regular session of the County Court of Deschutes County, Oregon, did not convene on the first Wednesday of February, which was February 6th, as the County Judge and County Commissioners were in Portland attending a meeting of the State Highway Commission.

The regular session was then held on Thursday, February 7th, 1918, in the County Judge's office. The meeting was called to order by the County Judge, W. D. Barnes, at 10 a. m., there being present, Judge Barnes, Commissioner C. H. Miller, of Redmond, and J. H. Haner, clerk.

Claims: The morning session was spent in auditing claims presented to the County for payment. After due consideration, it was ordered that claims No. 1692, No. 1694 to 1713 inclusive, No. 1715 to 1742 inclusive, No. 1746, 1747, 1749, 1751 to 1762 inclusive, No. 1765 to 1771 inclusive, No. 1773, 1774, 1775, 1781 and 1787 and 1788, as shown on pages 57, 58 and 59 of the Docket of Claims be and the same are hereby allowed, and the Clerk is instructed to issue his warrants in payment thereof.

On the motion duly made and seconded, Court adjourned to meet at 2:00 p. m.

The County Court reconvened at 2:00 o'clock p. m. Thursday, February 7, 1918, same members present as at morning session.

The afternoon session was spent in viewing roads. A trip was made over the Bend-Tumalo road, inspecting the cinder and surfacing of same; also inspecting the work on the hill south of Tumalo.

The session was then adjourned to meet Saturday, February 9, 1918, at 2:00 p. m.

The County Court met at 2:00 o'clock p. m. Saturday, February 9, 1918, pursuant to adjournment. The meeting was called to order by the County Judge, there being present Judge Barnes and Commissioner C. H. Miller of Redmond.

K. A. Nelson road: The Court went and viewed the K. A. Nelson road in Road Dist. 21.

No further matters coming up for consideration at this meeting, Court was adjourned until Wednesday, February 13, 1918.

The County Court met in the Court Room at 10:00 a. m. February 13, 1918, pursuant to adjournment. The meeting was called to order by the County Judge, there being present Judge Barnes, and Commissioner C. H. Miller of Redmond.

Various road matters were discussed at this time, among them being the K. A. Nelson road in Dist. 21. The meeting was then adjourned to meet at 2:00 p. m. same date.

The County Court reconvened at 2:00 p. m. February 13, 1918, pursuant to adjournment, same members being present as at the morning session.

K. A. Nelson road: This matter again came up for consideration. After due discussion, a stipulation and agreement was entered into by the parties concerned, upon suggestion of the County Court.

Claims: The matter of claims against the county coming up for consideration, same were audited, and it was ordered that Claims No. 1789 to 1831 inclusive, as shown on pages 61 and 62 of the Docket of Claims, be and the same are hereby allowed, and the Clerk is instructed to issue his warrants in payment thereof.

Geo. F. Funston road: The proper location of a part of this county road being in question, it was decided that nothing could be done in the matter, until the road was properly located by the County Surveyor, parties interested, agreeing to this decision. The matter was then left for further consideration.

Use of Court Room for Red Cross work: This matter came up for discussion at this time, and it was decided to let the Red Cross organization use that part of the Court Room

outside of the railing, except when the County needs the room for the uses and purposes for which it was originally designed.

No further business coming up for consideration at this time, on motion duly made and seconded, Court adjourned to meet Saturday, February 16th, for an inspection of road work.

Claims allowed at February 8th, term, 1918.

WHEREAS, the State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners is desirous of protecting the trout and other fish inhabiting the waters of said Paulina Creek, beginning at what is known as Big Paulina Falls, and thence running in an easterly direction for the distance of one-half mile to the approximate source of said creek in Paulina Lake, situate in Deschutes County, State of Oregon, NOW, THEREFORE, By authority of law vested in the said State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners, notice is hereby given that said waters of Paulina Creek, beginning at what is known as Big Paulina Falls, and thence running in an easterly direction for the distance of one-half mile to the approximate source of said creek in Paulina Lake, situate in Deschutes County, State of Oregon, is hereby closed to fishing of any kind or in any manner, for trout or other fish, from and after the 1st day of March, 1918, until said creek is opened again to fishing by the said State Board of Fish and Game Commissioners, as by statute provided.
