BUYS BENDVIEW WATER SYSTEM AND WILL INTRODUCE IMPROVEMENTS TO INSURE CONTINUOUS SUPPLY.

With the intention of providing more efficient service to water users, the Bend Water, Light & Power Co., has taken over the supplementary water system in Bendview operated up to now by A. J. Kroenert. While the small number of people now living in the high residence district of the westside makes ownership unprofitable, the company will look to the future. Manager T. H. Foley states, and will immediately take steps to insure an adequate water supply.

An automatic switch for the operation of the pump which fills the auxiliary reservoir, will be installed, so that the falling of the water in the tank to a certain level will start the pumping mechanism, while the filling of the tank will shut off the pump. The employment of a man to have charge of the pumping station will be rendered unnecessary by the use of this plan, while at the same time service will be more dependable.

During the past year, householders in Bendview have been without water for days at a time on several occasions.

KEYES AGAIN HEADS A. R. C.

CHAPTER ELECTIONS HELD ON FRIDAY AFTERNOON — INSTALLATIONS AND ANNUAL REPORTS DUE JANUARY 2.

For the third consecutive time J. P. Keyes was elected to head the Bend chapter of the American Red Cross, when a special session of the board of managers was held late Friday afternoon in the county court rooms. Mr. Keyes has headed the Red Cross chapter here since its organization in the first year of the war.

Others chosen for service during 1920 include Mrs. E. P. Mahaffey and R. W. Sawyer as vice-chairmen, E. M. Foss treasurer, and Mrs. Horace Richards, secretary, while committee heads consist of T. H. Foley, finances; Henry N. Fowler, publicity; Mrs. E. P. Mahaffey, production; Clyde McKay, Home Service, and J. A. Eastes, public health.

It was reported that plans to combine the home service department with civilian relief are still under consideration. Installation of officers and annual reports of officers and committees, will be held in the court rooms at 5 o'clock Friday afternoon.

C. O. I. DISTRICT WINS IN FIGHT

DESERT LAND BOARD VETOES CONTRACT FOR SALE OF WATER TO LONE PINE IRRIGATION DISTRICT.

Refusal of the Desert Land board to approve the proposed contract prepared by the Central Oregon Irrigation Company to furnish water to the Lone Pine Irrigation district for an area of approximately 1600 acres, was reported Monday from Salem, the decision coming as a distinct victory for the settlers on the C. O. I. project.

The irrigation company urged approval of the contract, but met strenuous opposition by the Central Oregon irrigation district. It was charged that the company had sufficient water to irrigate the Lone Pine lands, and that the contract was discriminatory in that it did not subject the lands included in the Lone Pine district to the same condition as lands in the Central Oregon irrigation project.

Another meeting of the board will be held two weeks hence, when the irrigation company will have an opportunity to submit another contract for consideration.





TIMBER SALE IS ANNOUNCED

\$56,427.50 PAID BY THE SHEVLIN-HIXON COMPANY FOR PARCELS OF LAND TOTALING NEARLY TWO SECTIONS.

Consummation of a deal for the transfer of nearly two sections of timber land in the Tumalo basin, by the Huron Timber Co., to The Shevlin-Hixon Company, was announced Monday. The consideration involved is \$56,427.50.

The transfer was virtually effected a year ago, but the final formalities had not been satisfied until last week, when the record of the sale was placed on file. The acreage purchased is in a number of small parcels scattered through the Tumalo timber belt.
