Creighton, Clearing Roads, FIX UP THE HENHOUSE, Winter is the season when the poultry keeper has most time at his disposal to use his hammer, saw, and nails in behalf of his flock. Many conveniences for the henhouse require only a little lumber and time for construction. If new nests, feed troughs, drinking fountains, or dust boxes in the biddies' domicile are needed, now is the time to make them. Perhaps the roosts need replacing. United States Department of Agriculture specialists recommend as a satisfactory perch a 2 by 3 inch scantling set edgewise with the upper edge slightly rounded. Allow 7 to 10 inches of perch for each fowl; that is, a perch 16 feet long would furnish room enough for 20 fowls. A smooth platform should be placed under the perches to catch the droppings. The perches should be from 6 to 10 inches above this

platform so as to allow the droppings to be removed without removing the perches. It is usually desirable to have the platform some distance from the floor, from 2 to 2 1/2 feet. In order that all the floor space may be available.
