Jim is a clown—that is his business. He can always do the wrong thing at the right time.

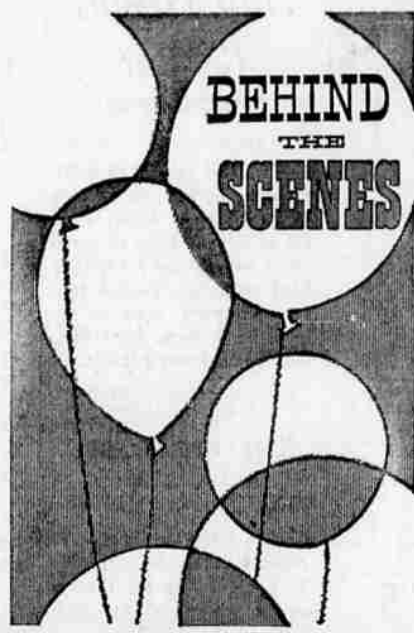
