FEPC was not included in JFK's proposed civil rights program

By Lyla C. Wilson UPI Staff Writer The orphan of the 1963 civil rights storm is the 1960 campaign promise to prevent racial job discrimination by means of federal law supported by federal penalties.

A Fair Employment Practices Commission (FEPC) was not included in the civil rights legislation proposed to Congress this week by President Kennedy.

"Finally, I renew my support of pending federal fair employment practices legislation, applicable to both employers and unions."

Chamber offers views on foreign aid program WASHINGTON (UPI) — The U.S. Chamber of Commerce said today the foreign aid program should concentrate on long range development programs that utilize private investment.

More than 20 witnesses were scheduled to testify before the committee, which resumed hearings on the aid bill.

Other congressional news: A House armed services subcommittee heard testimony on the administration's fallout shelter program.

Insurance: For at least the eighth time in recent years, the Senate Thursday passed legislation to give an estimated 16 million World War II and Korean War veterans a chance to reinstate lapsed G. I. insurance policies.

Handicapped Children: The House Education and Labor Committee approved a bill to provide \$115 million annually to help train teachers of handicapped children.

Parcel Post: The House Rules Committee cleared for floor action next week legislation to prevent sharp increases in parcel post rates.
