Golfers await 14th annual July 4 Mirror Pond test

Bend's premier links event of the year, the annual July Fourth Mirror Pond Amateur Tournament, will be played here Thursday and Friday.

A field of 100 golfers, including three former champions, will tee off in the 14th annual renewal of the 36 hole match play affair. Entrants will play 18 holes each day on Friday and Saturday.

The ladies portion of the tournament, with some 30 entries, will be played Friday afternoon and Saturday.

Defending champion Millard Porter of Madras heads the field this year. Porter fired rounds of 73 and 68 in taking the title last year.

Other former champions entered include Fred Hudspeth, the Prineville veteran who won in 1961 and Owen Panner, long time Bend player, who won the title in the late 50's. Also entered is former State Amateur titleholder George Beechler of Prineville.

Highly rated Doug Olson, the junior star from Medford who carries a one handicap, is also entered. Olson recently won the Oregon State Junior title at Eugene Country Club.

All three former champions are paired together. Panner, Hudspeth and Porter will tee off each day at 12:20. Paired with them is Jerry Cundari, former University of Oregon star, who plays out of Portland and carries a one handicap.

The tournament will be played in flights with gross and net prizes to winners and runners up in each flight.

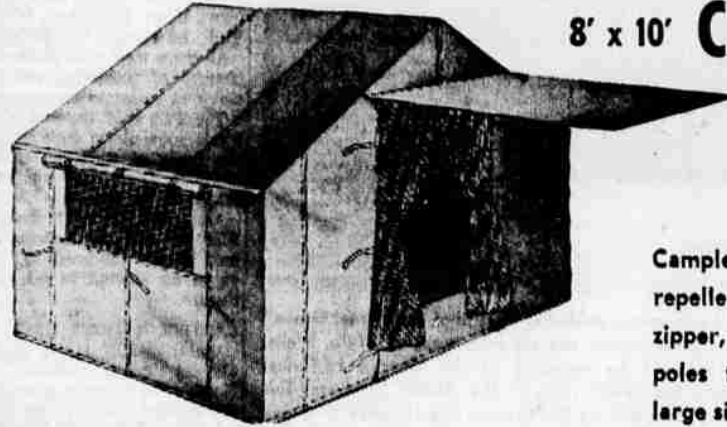

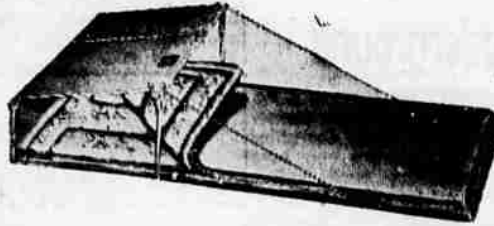
