8 accused of gambling get arraignment

PORTLAND (UPI)—Eight of thirteen men arrested here in a crackdown on alleged gambling operations were arraigned Tuesday in Multnomah County Circuit Court.

The men were arrested by city police and sheriff's deputies in a series of raids beginning July 4. All asked postponement of further pleadings until next Tuesday to give their attorneys time to study the charges.

Proceedings for four other men were postponed until Friday because their attorney was busy on another case.

One of the 13 men, William E. Payne, 22, who was charged with assault after he allegedly struck an officer during a raid, was scheduled to answer the charge in district court July 22.

Arraigned Tuesday on charges of gambling were William Whitehead, 36; Anthony Marconi, 49; Albert Battaglini, 51; Gordon Alvin Charles, 38; Walter Ekter, 50; Joseph Markel, 45; Fred Pattison, 76; and Glenn E. McQueen, 51.
