

Baker in good form as Rams lick Dallas, 20-17

PORTLAND (UPI) — Terry Baker may not have won the starting quarterback's job with the Los Angeles Rams Saturday night — but he didn't hurt his chances.

The rookie from Oregon State guided the Rams to a 20-17 National Football League exhibition win over the Dallas Cowboys before 29,349 persons here. It was the Rams' first victory and the Cowboys' initial defeat in three exhibition games this season.

"The starting quarterback job is wide open and always has been," Los Angeles Coach Harland Svare said after the game. Svare, whose quarterbacks corps includes sophomore Roman

Gabriel and veteran Zeke Bratkowski, would not divulge who would open at quarterback against the Cleveland Browns in the Rams' fourth exhibition game next weekend.

Called Most Plays

"It takes years to become a polished quarterback in this league but Terry was considerably better than a week ago (in part-time effort in a 27-3 loss to Minnesota)," the coach added. "He called 99 per cent of the plays tonight."

The victory, which came before the largest crowd ever to see a professional football game in

Multnomah Stadium, was the first for Los Angeles since last Oct. 28 when it defeated the San Francisco 49ers 28-14 in a league game. It was Svare's first win as head coach of the Rams.

Appropriately, Baker provided the Rams with their winning touchdown, a 44-yard pass to Peris Atkins on the first play of the final period.

Villanueva Adds Three Points

Trailing 17-10 at halftime, they collected a 23-yard field goal by Danny Villanueva in the third period.

The Heisman Trophy winner completed 12 of 20 passes for 192 yards and picked up 21 yards in

two runs. He had one pass intercepted.

Five other players with Oregon backgrounds also shared the spotlight.

Bill Swain, former University of Oregon center from North Bend, played the entire game at middle linebacker for the Rams in place of the injured Marlin McKeever.

Amos Marsh went most of the way at fullback for Dallas and gained a net of five yards on 10 carries. Mike Gaehter, formerly of Oregon, played the entire game in the Cowboys' defensive backfield, and Sam Baker, an ex-Beaver, did Dallas' punting and kicked a 45-yard field goal and

two extra points.

Bob Lilly, who played high school football at Pendleton before starting a fine college career at Texas Christian, started at a defensive end for the Cowboys.

The crowd was the largest ever to see a pro game in Multnomah Stadium.

Speedy Scot gets nod in Hambletonian

DU QUOIN, Ill. (UPI) — The oldest and youngest drivers in Wednesday's 30th Hambletonian trot classic have one thing in common.

Harry Pownall, 60, and Tom Graham, 26, both pick odds-on favorite Speedy Scot to win the event.

Pownall, who will guide Floris of the Arden Homestead Stable in the 14-horse field, drove his first winner 40 years ago.

"Speedy Scot is a great horse. If nothing happens, there could be a new Hambletonian record," he said.

"I think Speedy Scot looks as good as the great Greyhound did at the same age," Pownall added.

"Speedy Scot definitely is the

one to beat," said Graham, who will drive long shot Filter on Wednesday.

Odds-makers have listed Speedy Scot the 2-5 favorite and Glidden Hanover the second favorite at 5-1.

Cheer Honey, the filly that beat Speedy Scot at Roosevelt Raceway this season, was rated only 15-1 because of a virus infection.

Speedy Scot, owned by Castle-ton Farm, has the best time of any of the 14 entrants this year, 1:59 2/5, one second off the Hambletonian record set by Harlan Dean in 1961.

The big brown colt, which drew post position three alongside stablemate Captain's Boy, will be driven by Ralph Baldwin.

Rated the darkhorse in the trot

is Charles Hill's B. F. Coaltown, purchased three months ago for \$50,000. But B. F. Coaltown, like Cheer Honey, has been fighting off a virus with oxygen and antibiotic treatments.

Other horses named Sunday for the classic are Choir Boy, Careless Hanover, Dorado, trained by Captain's Boy's trainer; Diggs Dell and Buff Hanover, co-entries from Allwood Stable; Star Act and Elma.

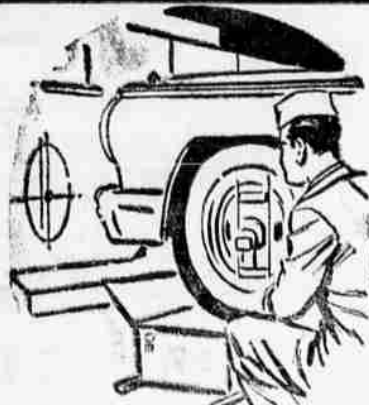
