

Ropers steal show in Round-up action

PENDELTON (UPI) —Ropers Dale Smith of Chandler, Ariz., and Brad Botta of Ellensburg, Wash., stole the show Thursday in the second day of the Pendleton Round-up rodeo.

Smith roped his calf in 11.6 seconds to shoot into the lead in that event with part of the second round completed. He had a total of 31.8 seconds on two calves.

Smith's time approached the Pendleton record of 11.4 set by Leonard Sayce in 1958 and the world record of 11.1.

Jerry Anderson, Ellensburg, Wash., and Don Posey, Mt. Vernon, Wash., trailed after two calves with 37.1 and 38.1, respectively.

Botta roped his steer in 15 seconds flat Thursday, but missed out on the lead in that event because of no time in his first try. Les Kamun, Pendleton, led with 41.9 seconds after the second round, followed by Dewey David, Riverton, Wyo., 42.3, and Harry Lynch, Coffeyville, Okla., 44.8.

Other day money winners Thursday were John Hawkins, Tustin, Calif., in bareback riding; Don Drake, Enumclaw, Wash., in bulldogging; Bill Martinell, Woodburn, Ore., in saddle bronc riding; and Frank Davis, Caldwell, Idaho, and Gid Garstad, Coronation, Alta., in brahma bull riding.

Leaders in those events were Dave Reidhead, Phoenix, Ariz., in bareback bronc riding after the

first go-round; Mark Schriker, Sutherlin, Ore., with 29.5 on two steers partway through the second go-round in steer wrestling; Kenny Stanton, Redmond, Ore., and Larry Hutchison, Calgary, tied partway through the first go-round of bull riding; and Jim Bohum, Redmond, and Kenny McLean, Okey Falls, B.C., tied after the first go-round of saddle bronc riding.

Other winners Thursday were Adolph Tratz, Coleman, Alta., in wild horse racing; Arvine Porter, Pilot Rock, Ore., in wild cow milking; the Benton County Posse of Corvallis, Ore., in the baton race, and the Walla Walla, Wash., Wagon Wheelers in the pony express race.

Away from the rodeo grounds Thursday, 11-year-old Lillian Moses of Pendleton won the Junior American Indian Beauty contest. Runners up were Ronna Jean Cowapo, 7, and Mildred Quampts, 10, both of Pendleton.

Majors reject Am. Assn. plan
