NATIONAL FOREST CHRISTMAS TREES

Oral auction bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor or his authorized representative, Bend City Hall, Commission Room, Bend, Oregon, beginning at 9:00 a.m., October 2, 1963, prior to the beginning of the oral auction, sealed bids will be received at the Forest Supervisor's Office, 745 Bond Street, Bend, Oregon, for the designated number of white fir, Shasta red fir, lodgepole pine, and incense cedar suitable for U.S. Grade No. 2 and better Christmas trees, varying from 3 to 14 feet in total height, located on the following described areas on the Bend, Crescent, Port Rock, Metolius, and Sisters Ranger Districts, Deschutes National Forest, Prospective bidders are urged to examine the sale areas in which they are interested before bidding. Maps outlining the areas on the five Districts mentioned are obtained from the District Ranger for the areas to be sold on his District.

1. Ketch-Ketch Butte Area, embracing about 2,300 acres, located in Sections 10, 11, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27; T. 21 S., R. 7 E.; W.M. surveyed, containing 400 white fir U.S. Grade No. 2 and better Christmas trees.

2. Coyote Springs Area, embracing about 3,300 acres, located in Section 36; T. 18 S., R. 10 E.; and Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, and 24; T. 19 S., R. 10 E.; W.M. surveyed, containing 300 lodgepole pine U.S. Grade No. 2 and better Christmas trees.
