US trying to retain prestige

DALMAHOY, Scotland (UPI) — Dave Ragan and Billy Maxwell, two slightly deflated members of the United States Ryder Cup team, led five other Yanks in action today in the \$22,400 Senior Service Golf Tournament.

The 72-hole event on the 6,663-yard, par-71 Dalmahoys course should provide Ragan and Maxwell with a chance to regain some of the prestige they lost in Wednesday's "Little Ryder Cup" matches on the same links.

Maxwell, of Las Vegas, Nev., and Ragan, who plays out of Orlando, Fla., suffered bad beatings as a team of British pros upset a makeshift U.S. squad by a total of six holes.

Neil Coles, a chunky Englishman who already has been named to the British Ryder Cup team, will meet the U.S. at Atlanta next month, overpowered Ragan, 7-up, Scotland's Eric Brown turned back Maxwell, 4-up.
