Medical group shuns stand on tax referendum

PORTLAND (UPI)—The House of Delegates of the Oregon Medical Society last week refused to endorse the legislature's \$60 million revenue increase which faces a referendum Oct. 15.

A resolutions committee recommendation that the society support the ballot measure died when members decided to take no stand.

Dr. William Scott, chairman of the resolutions committee, said the majority report issued by his group reflected some displeasure with the tax program, but considered the situation would become even more chaotic if the measure were defeated.

The society refused even to go along with that stand.
