Rural housing loans available

REDMOND — Glenn J. Barnes, county supervisor for the Farmers Home Administration, has announced that FHA can make rural housing loans under the Housing Act of 1949, as amended.

These loans are made to farm owners and owners of other real estate in rural areas and small rural communities with populations up to 2500, which are not part of an urban area. Funds may be used to finance construction, repair and remodeling of adequate modest rural dwelling and essential farm service buildings. There are special provisions for rural senior citizens 62 years of age or over. They may use loan funds to purchase a previously occupied house or to buy a site on which to build a home or add to and repair an existing home. The funds cannot be used to refinance debts, says Barnes. To be eligible, an applicant must be without decent, safe and sanitary housing, be unable to finance the needed improvements with his own resources or with credit from other sources. Those wishing further information are asked to call at the FHA office in Redmond, headquarters for Deschutes and Crook Counties.
