At this time the Court resolved to budget \$10,000.00 yearly for the city of Bend, Redmond and Sisters in Deschutes County from the Road Department Fund, to be used by them in construction or maintenance of city streets.

IN THE MATTER OF SALE OF CINDER ROCK AND BUILDING ROCK: The Court agreed to sell Herbert Gascon, 3125 N.E. 23rd Ave., Portland, Ore., cinder rock from the County cinder pit in Hillman Township at the rate of 10 cents per yard.
