U.S. recognized Soviet regime 30 years ago, on Nov. 16, 1933

By Bart Kinch UPI Staff Writer Thirty years ago, on Nov. 16, 1933, the United States recognized the Soviet regime. At the time it was hoped that future years would witness a tremendous growth in friendship and understanding between the two nations.

Such has not been the case. The two great powers, allied by necessity during World War II, have remained armed camps, both packing a nuclear punch. "Incidents" appear to be the rule rather than the exception. With the recent signing of the nuclear test ban treaty, it was hoped that there would be a further easing in East-West tensions. But the Soviet Union quickly dispelled any such hope by harassing U.S. troop movements from West Germany to West Berlin.

This week the Russians went a step farther with the announcement of the arrest of a graying, 52-year-old political science professor from Yale University on spy charges.

Strobe won top honors among all the state's fourth year electrical apprentices on his knowledge and techniques of the trade. He was top scorer in the state inside electrician's contest held in Eugene September 14.

Award certificates for second, third, fourth and fifth places in the contest will also be presented. Each of the new journeymen will receive the full recognition of his journeyman standing in electrical skills, including a State of Oregon Completion Certificate, the NECA - IBEW National Completion Certificate and medallion, and the IBEW pin.

Over 100 are expected to attend the banquet and presentation program which follows an afternoon meeting of the State Inside Electrical Trades Apprenticeship Committee to be held in Room 2 of the Pilot Butte Inn.

Jack Schiller of Salem, John Beasley of Madras, Homer Smith of Bend, and Glen McCall and Carl Sorensen of Eugene are in charge of arrangements for the event.

PRINEVILLE — The city judge's roster was more than ordinarily full during October, according to city court records for the month. Folk-music specialist due

A folk-music specialist who is one of America's rare "historians" in this kind of music, will be the guest of Knife and Fork Club members at their meeting in Redmond Tuesday evening, November 19.

He is Robert Calderwood, a native of California who now lives in Denver, Colo. The dinner meeting, in the Westminster Hall, will start at 7 p.m., Gifford M. Briggs, club secretary, has announced.

Most everyone is familiar with the "yankee drawl", the southern "soft accent" and the westerner's "brogue", but, according to Calderwood, the different kinds of music that have been favorites of geographical areas are even more pronounced and distinctive than the language accent of these areas.

A young fellow, still in his twenties, Calderwood began the study of folk music at an early age. He holds several degrees in his specialized field. Not only is Calderwood a "researcher" and historian of music, but he sings the folk songs of the different historical areas, accompanying himself expertly on a guitar.

Washington — President Kennedy's \$11 billion tax cut bill ran afoul of the Senate Finance Committee which voted against speeding up hearings on the bill. The vote killed any serious prospects for passage at this session of Congress.

Vatican City — The Ecumenical Council next week will begin debate on a document which reportedly opens new horizons toward the goal of Christian unity. Council delegates were reported enthusiastic about the report.

Buenos Aires — Argentina canceled all oil development contracts with eight American and two European companies Friday, leaving in doubt the \$397 million U.S. oil firms have tied up in Argentine fields.

Sao Paulo — A \$20 billion inter American aid fund will be taken up for study by a newly formed agency for coordination of U.S. aid to Latin America. Agreement to study the aid program came after a week of meetings among Latin American nations and U.S. Undersecretary of State Averell Harriman.

Washington — The Senate this week approved a \$3.7 billion foreign aid proposal. The bill now goes to a Senate-House conference committee to compromise differences between the bills approved by the two houses. The House approved a \$3.5 billion version.

Baghdad, Iraq — The international command council of the ruling Baath Party assumed control of Iraq after an attempted coup Wednesday. The council said the situation was "dangerous" but there was calm and little evidence of armed troops in Baghdad.

Boardman snarl being pondered by legislators

SALEM (UPI) — Is the Boardman project the beginning of a great industrial complex in the sandy wastelands of northeastern Oregon, or is it one of the biggest boondoggles in Oregon history?

Lawmakers pondered that question today after being told they would have to pounce on \$522,000 in addition to the \$900,000 they have already authorized for the project.

In a special message, Gov. Mark Hatfield asked the legislature to pass emergency legislation to clear legal entanglements holding up completion of the project.

"Without such legislation this project may fail," Hatfield warned.

The governor's emergency bill was rushed to the Ways and Means Committee, which was told that if the legal cloud was not cleared, the Boeing Co. wouldn't honor the 77-year lease it signed July 1.

That would leave Oregon with 34,000 acres, for which it already has paid \$753,000.

Enthusiasm Lacking There was no indication lawmakers would rush in at once to pull the Boardman chestnuts out of the fire. Further hearings were scheduled.

Secretary of State Howell Appleby Jr. termed the project "like jumping out of an airplane—once you jump, it's too late to change your mind."

"We're past the point of no return. I wish we had never started."

But Sam Mallicoat, state planning and development director who has mothered the project since it was launched three years ago, said "Boardman has the potential of becoming a tremendous industrial complex."

Boeing has refused to activate the lease because common school lands, which have special legal status, have been involved.

Plan Complicated The bill proposed by the governor involves a complicated series of legal maneuvers designed to clear any possible legal cloud.

The plan: —Borrow \$1 million from the public employees retirement fund and the industrial accident fund.

—Pay the Navy \$522,000 cash for clear title to land once owned by the service.

—Pay \$385,000 to buy the school lands in the tract.

—Pay \$92,000 for added expenses.

—Have the common school fund buy the \$1 million loan.

—Have \$50,000 a year of the \$60,000 annual rental fee go to the School Fund to repay the loan.

—Keep the extra \$10,000 as a "cushion" to pay for insurance (there still are unexploded bombs on the land) and operation, which will come to about \$2,000 a year, and set aside the remaining \$8000 to pay taxes to Morrow County.
