31,600 FLEE CHINA
LONDON (UPI) — The Commonwealth and Colonial Office reported today that more than 31,600 persons entered Hong Kong from Communist China during the past 12 months...

It added that the Hong Kong government has provided housing for about 750,000 persons since 1948. More than 600,000 "squatters" are yet to be resettled.

Grading work gets underway

Work preliminary to the grading of a new unit of the Central Oregon Highway over Horse Ridge, eliminating the present section of many sharp curves, has been started by a Groesbeck-Durbin crew.

The Eugene contracting firm submitted the low bid when proposals for the clearing and grading of a 2.45 mile section of the road was opened in Salem on November 19...

According to information from Oregon State Highway Department engineers, the Eugene firm moved a crew into the area this week, to start clearing the new route. Grading work will continue into the winter.

The new section reaches up the northern slope of Horse Ridge close to the Dry River gorge, and in a few places will be near the brink of that ancient canyon.
