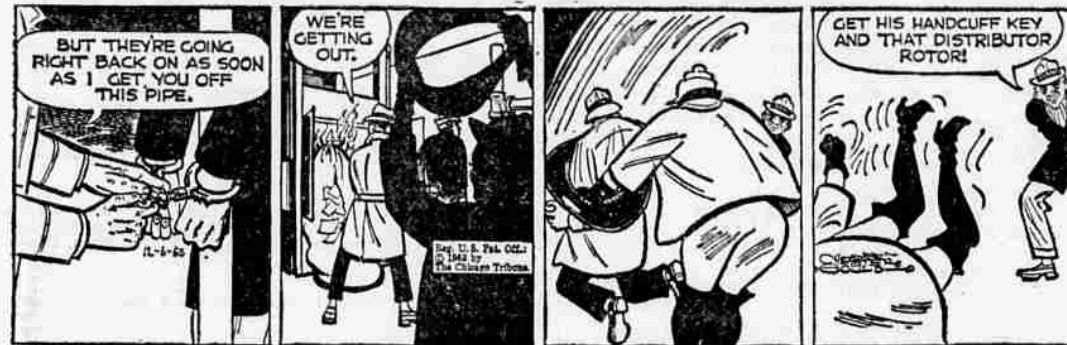

Odds increase that Tiger will beat Joey Giardello

ATLANTIC CITY (UPI)—Midweight champion Dick Tiger advanced a half-point in the betting odds today to beat challenger Joey Giardello in their 15-round title fight Saturday night at Convention Hall.

The odds lengthened from 3-1 to 3 1/2-1 that 34-year-old Tiger of Nigeria will defeat 33-year-old Giardello of Cherry Hill, N.J., although each won a decision in their two previous non-title 10-round bouts.

Promoter Murray Goodman said he expects a crowd of 14,000 and a gate of \$125,000 in the huge hall where the annual

Miss America Pageant is held. Although the hall could seat 40,000 it has been set up to accommodate only 18,000. There will be no television or radio.

Both fighters kept limber today with moderately long walks and with room exercises at their hotels. Each is expected to weigh in Saturday just below the 160-pound limit.

Tiger is the heavy favorite because he is unbeaten in his last 10 bouts, which included one draw; also because he is believed to have more stamina and ruggedness than the challenger.
