Exp., \$17, IN THE MATTER OF DEEDS TO COUNTY OWNED LANDS: The Court executed a deed to Keith Cyrus conveying a tract of land in NE 1/4 of Sec. 14, Twp. 15 S., R. 15 W., described as follows: Beginning at a point on N. r.w line of Old Sisters Wagon Rd. (Jordan Co. Road) which rd. is located 1406' S. and 314.78' W. of NE corner of said Sec. 14, and running thence N. 27 degrees E. - 693.7 ft.; thence S. 1 degree 11' E. - 760.3 ft.; thence N. 66 degrees 45' W. - 360 ft. to point of beginning and 3 acres, more or less in exchange for a 3 acre tract of land owned by Keith Cyrus in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 13, Twp. 15 S.R. 10 E. W.M. IN THE MATTER OF LEASING COUNTY OWNED LANDS: The Court leased Rodney Rosebrook 801.53 acres in Sections 5, 6, 7 & 8, Twp. 20 S.R. 16 E. W.M. for cultivation & farming purposes at the rate of 50 cents per acre, payable in 3 equal annual installments, beginning on or before Dec. 31, 1963, and also leased Rodney Rosebrook 11,078 acres for grazing purposes only in Twp. 19, Range 14, 15 & 16 and Twp. 20, Range 15 & 16 at 30 cents per acre, payable \$553.92 annually. Lease to run to Dec. 31, 1969. IN THE MATTER OF EXTENSION TO DORRENCE MEADOWS ROAD: The Court at this time said in holding on the advertised hearing of the establishment of extension of Dorrence Meadows Road. There being no objections to the establishment of the above mentioned road, the extension to the Dorrence Meadows Road was declared established.
