Foursquare Church of Redmond
Rev. William R. Cooke

One of the oldest congregations in Redmond, The Foursquare Gospel Church had its inception in a tent revival meeting which opened July 26, 1928, when a party of musicians and ministers from Los Angeles responded to an invitation from laymen who were already engaged in Sunday School work in the community. Organized following the tent meeting, the congregation applied for and received a charter from the International Church of the Foursquare Gospel founded by the late Aimee Semple McPherson, being granted charter and recognition in January of 1931.

Early services were conducted in several rented locations until a vacated church building in the country was purchased and moved

onto the present site in 1931. From this beginning in the early years of the community, the Foursquare church has served as an evangelistic center in the city, offering a full gospel ministry, an intensive youth program, and a strong missionary endeavor.

The International Church of the Foursquare Gospel, while one of the smaller denominations, maintains mission work on twenty-eight foreign fields outside of the U.S. and Canada, and maintains more churches on the foreign field than exist on the home base. The Redmond church has contributed young people both into the missionary program and to the ministry on the home field.

Included in the program of the church are a departmentalized

Sunday School, Junior Church and nursery care during Worship services, a training hour graded by age and interest into five active groups, three choirs, a chapter of United Foursquare women composed of two circles and a girls' auxiliary, a chapter of Council of Foursquare Men chartered this year, a Junior club, and a variety of other activities.

The church is in the midst of a building program which will see it established in up-to-date and enlarged quarters, with one unit 90% complete to be followed by a second unit.

Rev. and Mrs. William R. Cooke have served as pastors since June of 1956. They were joined in July of 1961 by Miss June McGuire who serves as assisting minister.
