Central Oregon water outlook is fairly good

The 1964 water supply outlook for Deschutes, Jefferson, and Crook counties is fairly good, according to a report released today by T. P. Helseth, State Conservationist of the Soil Conservation Service (USDA), co-operating with Oregon State University, Oregon State Engineer and others. The snowpack, although better than last year, is still well below average and reservoir storage, although good, is slightly below last year on January 1.

Water content of the snowpack is 75 per cent greater than last year on January 1 but is still only 41 per cent of average for the Upper Deschutes-Crooked River Basin as a whole.

Marks Creek soil moisture is 65 per cent of total capacity or about 6 per cent less than last year on January 1.

Crooked River reservoirs, Ochoco and Prineville, contain 21,300 acre feet and 99,700 acre feet respectively, which in total is slightly more than last year on January 1 and about average.

Deschutes River reservoirs contain about 10 per cent less water than last year on January 1. Wickiup now holds 117,100 acre feet, Crane Prairie 34,600 a.f. and Crescent Lake, 42,500 acre feet. The total of these three reservoirs is about 7 per cent above average. Crane Prairie and Crescent Lake are 3 per cent below average and Wickiup is 15 per cent above the 1943-57 average period on January 1.

Flow of the Deschutes at Moody, from preliminary streamflow data furnished by U.S. Geological Survey, Portland, Oregon, was 78 per cent of average for December and has been 90 per cent of average for the October - December period.

The next report on snow surveys and water supply conditions in Oregon will be issued about February 10, 1964.

Mental health film showing due January 14

The dramatic 80-minute film, "91st Day," will be shown Tuesday, January 14, at 7:30 p.m. at the Tower Theater. The showing is co-sponsored by the United Church Women of Bend and the Central Oregon Mental Health Association, as a community service. The theater is offering the use of its facilities, and there will be no admission charge.

Patrick O'Neal and Madeleine Sherwood, veterans of movie and stage work and more recently in television, are starred in the drama. It tells the story of a woman who refuses to resign herself to the inevitability of lifelong hospitalization of her husband, who falls victim to a delusion that disrupts his life. She determines to create for him a "91st day."

The film is directed by Lee R. Bobker, an Oregonian from Portland, who was associate producer of the Academy Award nominee and Venice Film Festival award winner, "David and Lisa."

The film, inspired by the report to Congress by the Joint Commission on Mental Illness and Health, was premiered on the national educational television network last November. It was produced for the National Association for Mental Health, Inc., under the auspices of Smith Kline and French Laboratories of Philadelphia.
